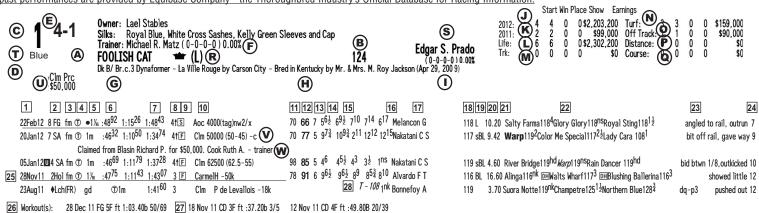
How to Read the Program

The information is provided as an example of all the components found within a race program in an effort to educate and inform the betting public. All past performances are provided by Equibase Company - the Thoroughbred Industry's Official Database for Racing Information.

- · ALW 34000N\$Y (allowance, purse 34,000 non-winners of specified money in the year)
