

# 2026 POWER BINGO RULES

## **PURCHASE, BINGO RESERVATIONS PROCESS AND GENERAL RULES**

1. Players must be at least 21 (twenty-one) years of age with valid ID to be eligible to participate in the Bingo Event.
2. Purchase your \$345 (three hundred and forty-five dollars) Entry Fee "9-on pack" on the Boyd web page to reserve the property you wish to play.
3. \$345 (three hundred and forty-five dollars) Entry Fee includes:
  - One 9-on Pack for Each Event Day
  - Food Vouchers
  - One Dauber
  - One Souvenir
4. The player must present their Boyd Rewards card and \$345 Entry to the agent to receive their "9-on pack" each day. ALL warm-up packs and extra pack purchases are cash only on the day of the event.
5. Warm-up games will begin at 11:30am for each property (this session is not linked). To play warm-up games, guests must have purchased a buy-in "9-on pack" for the main POWER BINGO event prior to being able to purchase and play the warm-up games. Warm-up packs are \$5 (five dollars) each for a "6-on pack". Warm-up games are played as games 1-10 (one through ten) and pays \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) each game. There are no limits for purchasing warm-up packs.
6. Main event of the POWER BINGO games will begin at 1:00pm. Guests must purchase the minimum buy-in "9-on pack" and are valid games 11-30 (eleven through thirty) of each day. Games 11-27 (eleven through twenty-seven) pay \$10,000 (ten thousand dollars). Game 28 (twenty-eight) pays \$50,000 (fifty thousand dollars). Game 29 (twenty-nine) pays \$20,000 (twenty thousand dollars). Game 30 (thirty) pays \$10,000 (ten thousand dollars).
7. Electronic players must purchase a minimum of 2 (two) additional 6-on packs for a total of \$50 (fifty dollars) per day or purchase any electronic package and your 9-on pack.
8. There is a maximum of 50 (fifty) extra "6-on packs" extra packs plus your buy-in "9-on pack" in the electronic unit. Free packs are not included in this maximum.
9. No more than 3 (three) of each; warm-up/extra paper packs per seat for each session.
10. Additional "3-on coverall strips" are available at the time of purchase until the start of game 21 (twenty-one) for \$5 (five dollars) each. Maximum of 50 (fifty) in the electronic unit.
11. No coupons or other discounts will be valid unless stated for Power Bingo and the date of the Power Bingo event will be accepted. No Boyd points/scripts (dollars) will be accepted for this event.
12. Any paper or electronic unit purchased must be used at the session it was purchased. Only cards sold for the current Bingo Event are eligible. Cards sold at previous events or sessions will be declared void and will not be considered a winning card, due to serial numbers on packs.
13. Once the Bingo game starts, the balls will be shown on camera and called. The ball on camera is not official until it is called. Once the agent starts calling a letter/number, the caller must finish calling the letter/number.
14. To be a valid winner, the player must have the last number called. It is the players responsibility to stop the game by calling out "BINGO" loud and clear and raising your hand, paper, or electronic unit in the air so the caller/agents on the floor can see and hear you to stop the game.
15. The player must be present and playing the paper/electronic unit to be verified as a winner. Only one electronic unit per player is allowed. Anyone playing more than one unit will be disqualified.
16. If the player needs to leave the room for any reason, please notify a bingo agent. The bingo agent will turn off the player's electronic machine until the player returns. Bingo agents cannot watch or play any electronic units or paper packs.
17. Each player may designate one substitute to play on their behalf if the session cannot be played by the original player for any reason. Each substitute must meet all bingo requirements and if a jackpot is won during this time it will be paid to and recorded for whoever is playing at that time, regardless of purchaser or original player.
18. It is the players responsibility to check their receipts and make sure all orders are listed correctly at the time of purchase. Receipts and Boyd Rewards cards should be visible on the table while playing bingo. Any cards that are torn or mutilated in anyway will not qualify as a valid card and will not be paid as a winner.
19. All monies will be aggregate among all participating properties, which is the total number of winners per game divided into the value received for the card purchased.
20. All paper cards must be marked with a dauber that is readable.
21. You must have the last number called and the pattern that is on the display boards around the room to be a valid winner.
22. Any and all applicable taxes required are the sole responsibility of the player.
23. In case of an emergency, please contact the bingo room for a refund.
24. This Bingo linked system will be operated at Gold Coast Hotel & Casino, Suncoast Hotel & Casino and Sam's Town Hotel & Gambling Hall, Las Vegas (hereinafter the "properties"). Gold Coast will be the hub. The Bingo linked system permits live broadcasting of the Boyd Gaming Bingo game activity from an individual property's Bingo room to each of the other properties' Bingo rooms.
25. From time to time, an individual property may elect not to participate on a specific date or session in the Bingo game. The dates and sessions of "non-participation" will be conspicuously posted in the respective property's Bingo room at least 24 (twenty-four) hours prior to the scheduled Bingo game.
26. Progressive games that are played at individual properties will not be available at this special session, including but not limited to; Cashballs, Hotballs, Bonus Ball, Second Chance Hotball, Second Chance Cashball, "G" Ball, Progressive Letter "X", Progressive Coveralls, Progressive Bonus Coverall, Double Daub Progressives, Mini Double Daub Progressive, or Mini Kicker Progressives due to this special session(s).
27. The Bingo rooms will be linked by live broadcast (televised video and audio) and by telephone call conferencing. The Bingo Agent will be at a desk in each of the Bingo rooms monitoring the live broadcast and telephone. In the event of a malfunction with the live broadcast, the Bingo Agent at that property will alert the other properties by telephone of the malfunction. The Bingo games caller will then transmit to his/her respective property that there is a malfunction at one of the properties and the Bingo game will be paused for a few moments to correct the malfunction.
28. Regular verification procedures will be followed at whichever property the win occurs. It is announced to the other properties that a potential winner has called "Bingo", so no more numbers are called pending the verification of the game. Once the game is verified, the property at which the Bingo was hit is also responsible for paying the patron. In the case of multiple winners, the jackpot is split among all winners, with each property responsible for paying at their respective properties.
29. These rules or this Bingo game may be modified or canceled by management at any time at its sole discretion.
30. Rules will be posted in each of the participating BOYD GAMING POWER BINGO rooms and supersede any rules posted on the internet.

31. Boyd reserves the sole and absolute discretion to determine if a player is an "advantage player," and therefore ineligible to participate in any Promotion, or to have his/her ability to participate in these Promotion otherwise limited.

a. Any such "advantage player" who is already a player club member prior to the commencement of the Promotion may be notified by Boyd prior to the commencement of the Promotion of any such ineligibility or limitation determination. Otherwise, any such "advantage player" will be notified by Boyd of any ineligibility or limitation determination as soon as possible after such determination is made. An "advantage player" is described as a skilled or knowledgeable player who will find legal ways to gain mathematical advantages while gambling.

32. Bingo employees of Gold Coast, Suncoast, and Sam's Town, Fortunet and their affiliate companies are not eligible to participate in this Bingo Event. Management reserves the right to exclude any individual from the game at any time.

33. Any dispute or situation not covered by these rules shall be resolved by the property's management in a manner that is fair to all parties. If the patron is not satisfied with management's decision, he or she may exercise their rights under NRS 463.361 et seq. and request the Nevada Gaming Control Board to review the matter.

## **PROCEDURES IN THE EVENT OF TECHNICAL ISSUES**

### **1. Loss of Video Signal**

In the event of the loss of video signal, the game can continue utilizing the following procedures. First, the host site will call the ball in his/her ball rack which is communicated to all participants via a data link which is independent of the video link system. The caller at participating locations then echoes the ball call at their participating location causing no delay in call of the game.

### **2. Loss of Data and Video Signal**

The same as above, except that the caller must select the caller ball in his/her ball rack and echo the ball call back to his/her participating Bingo Room.

### **3. Loss of Telephone Communication**

If telephone communication is lost between participants, the game is stopped. The game can resume when a cell phone or other telephone communication device has been procured and participating operations are back on live communication.

### **4. Miscellaneous**

In the event that the Boyd Rewards kiosk, Slot System, Promotion System or Drawing System is inoperable or malfunctions, Management reserves the right to cancel or modify this process in a manner fair to all parties involved.

## **SPECIAL ROOM OFFERS**

Based on availability. Room costs are not included in the Power Bingo Entry Fee. Purchase Sunday, prior to the event days for a special rate (plus tax & resort fee), get Monday and Tuesday of the event free.

## **CONSOLATION GUARANTEED PRIZE DRAWING OFFICIAL RULES**

1. All customers must swipe their BOYD REWARDS card at the time of pack purchases each day of the Power Bingo Event to be eligible for the consolation Prize Drawing that is in conjunction with the \$500,000 (five hundred thousand dollar) Power Bingo Event. Each customer will receive 1 (one) "virtual" ticket for each of the days of the Power Bingo Event.
2. All drawing entries are "virtual" and will be electronically deposited into our cyber drawing drum prior to the start of the drawings each day. The drawing tickets will stay in the drawing drum throughout the duration of all the drawings each day. Participants may win up to a maximum of 1 (one) consolation prize per day. At the end of the first POWER BINGO event day, the entries will be removed and started again the next day with each customer's entry being electronically deposited into our cyber drawing drum.
3. At the completion of each game of the Power Bingo Event, each of the properties that do not have a winning Bingo will have a drawing.
4. The drawings for the Consolation Prize Drawing games 11-27 pay \$250 (two hundred fifty dollars), game 28 pays \$1,000 (one thousand dollars), and games 29 and 30 pay \$500 each day.
5. Players must be present and playing the session to win. Winners must present a valid photo I.D. and Boyd Rewards card within 30 (thirty) seconds of the ticket being drawn to be considered present. If the winner is not present within this time period, additional tickets will be drawn until the prize is properly claimed and verified by a bingo agent/supervisor.
6. Participants must be at least 21 (twenty-one) years old and a valid Boyd Rewards member. Play without a Boyd Rewards card slide does not qualify for the drawings. Membership in Boyd Rewards is free and available at the Boyd Rewards club.
7. No substitutions or transfer of prize by winners permitted.
8. Participation in this promotion constitutes entrants' agreement to abide by the rules of this promotion.
9. Any and all applicable taxes, fees and licenses required relating to the winning of any of the above-described prizes are the sole and absolute responsibility of the winner.
